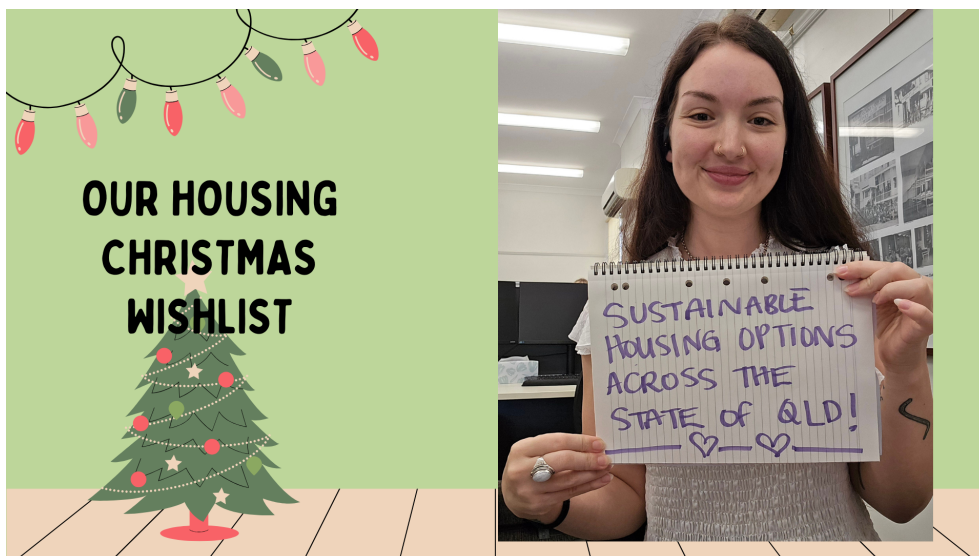
When we think of all we've been able to do with your input and support over the past 12 months, it makes us excited to think of what we can achieve together in 2025.
